

AMRITSAR KOLKATA INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR (AKIC)

Location

- The Amritsar-Delhi-Kolkata Industrial Corridor Project, an economic corridor to connect Amritsar, Delhi and Kolkata under the Industrial Zone, has been approved by the GOI along the Eastern Dedicated Freight corridor.
- Out of 1839 km long EDFC, Uttar Pradesh has the highest share of around 57% measuring 1,049 kms., dissecting the State. UPSIDC is developing AKIC along this portion of EDFC.
- 18 encompassing Districts in U.P. are Chandauli, Varanasi, Mirzapur Allahabad, Kaushambi, Fatehpur, Kanpur(Urban), Kanpur(Rural), Auraiya, Etawah, Ferozabad, Agra, Hathras, Aligarh, Bulandshahr, Ghaziabad, Gautambudh Nagar, Meerut, Muzaffar Nagar, Saharanpur.

Features

- UPSIDC nominated as Nodal Agency for implementing the U.P. section of EDFC.
- 3 Integrated Manufacturing Clusters (IMC), of about 25000 acres each, proposed: Kanpur, Allahabad, Aligarh-Agra and identified area has been notified under U.P. State INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (UPSIDA).
- Land at Bhaupur under Kanpur IMC identified and action initiated to develop a Modern Self-Contained Township there having Industrial, Residential, Commercial and Support sectors.
- Land already identified by CONCOR for setting up a container depot/logistics park near Bhaupur.
- UPSIDC and DDFCIL planning to form a Joint Venture for setting up a logistics park near new Sarsaul railway station.
